

# CORN HALL GENERAL INFORMATION (November 2016)

Recently the subject of a major £2 million refurbishment project, with funding from the Heritage Lottery Fund, this Grade II listed building in the heart of Diss now offers a beautifully restored historic building, upto-date facilities and flexible accommodation at a reasonable cost.

Principle uses include concerts, theatre, wedding receptions, dinners, dances, indoor sport, exhibitions, fairs, seminars, meetings, lectures and auctions.

### **SPACES**

## The Hall

This impressive high-ceilinged hall in classical style is 22.8m x 12.8m (75' x 42') with a ceiling height of 6.4m (21'). The Main Hall can cater for 300 seated (164 on fully retractable travelling tiered seating), 180 dining or 400 standing. The space includes a lighting rig with theatre lighting, sound control booth, projector and motorised screen. There is a superb dance floor and tables and chairs can be provided and set up to individual requirements.

The stage in the Assembly Hall measures  $7.3 \text{m} \times 3.7 \text{m} \times 800 \text{mm}$  (24' X 12' x 2.5'). With advance notice it may be possible to increase the stage to  $7.3 \text{m} \times 4.9 \text{m}$  (24' x 16') and to set the front section of the stage at a lower height. Please note: increasing the stage dimensions reduces the hall seating capacity.

## The Waveney Room

At 5.7m x 9.1m (19' x 30'), the Waveney Room is ideal for medium-sized gatherings, holding 50 seated or 30 dining. With a new professionally run bar and café adjoining the space, this facility is both welcoming and versatile. The room is equipped with projector, large motorised screen and PA.

## The Studio (upstairs but with lift access)

Measuring  $5.7 \text{m} \times 10 \text{m}$  (19'  $\times 33'$ ), The Studio is ideal for classes, training, small boardroom-style meetings, intimate receptions and workshops. The space can accommodate up to 50 and has access to upstairs toilet facilities and the option of a private entrance.

## The Gallery

We hold approximately six art and six heritage exhibitions per year in the main Gallery. These show a rich mix of established artists. In Gallery 2 upstairs we also feature regularly changing themed exhibitions and artists from the local community.

## The Box Office

The Box Office is open from Monday to Friday, 10am to 4pm, Saturday 10am to 2pm, and at least 2 hrs before performances.

# **Dressing Room/Green Room**

The dressing room is equipped with makeup mirrors, a full length mirror and has wifi access. The space can be divided into two for privacy. An iron and ironing board are available on request. Toilets and a tea point adjoin. The Studio may be used for larger groups if necessary – please ask. The Dressing Room is on the first floor and access to the stage is down a performer's stair. There is lift access to the ground floor if necessary.

# Bar & Café

Both the café and the bar are open from 10am-4pm Monday-Saturday, from 6pm on event nights and 2 hrs prior to Sunday performances.

Fredricks Fine Foods provide a delicious range of teas, coffees and soft drinks, plus a wonderful menu of freshly-made cakes, snacks and pre-show suppers. The award-winning, local and very popular Grain Brewery continue to run our bar.

#### Access

The Main Hall and the Waveney Room are both on the ground floor with access just a short distance from the car park with no flights of stairs. The Studio is on the first floor and is served by a lift. There are toilets including accessible toilets on both floors. The Main Hall and Waveney Room have hearing loops.

## **FURNITURE**

# Main Hall seating & capacity

300 seated (164 on fully retractable travelling tiered seating unit), 180 dining or 400 standing.

## Chairs

In addition to the tipping chairs fixed to the retractable unit, we have 150 padded stacking chairs.

#### **Tables**

We have 20 x 6' trestle tables which can comfortably seat six people for dining and 8 for cabaret-style events.

# **Acoustic screens**

We have 8 x black cloth-covered, free-standing acoustic absorber screens 6' x 3.5' which may be used as wings or scenery flats.

## LOCATION

Diss is located on the Norfolk-Suffolk border more-or-less midway between Norwich and Ipswich on the A140 and on the A1066 approximately 20 miles from Thetford.

The Corn Hall is in the centre of the town on St Nicholas Street. Approaching from the A140 drive along Victoria Road/Park Road and turn right into Denmark Street at the Park Hotel roundabout, go up the hill and, immediately after the zebra crossing, turn right into St Nicholas Street. The Corn Hall is the large columned building about 30 metres down on your left. You can drive into the yard between The Two Brewers pub and the Corn Hall to unload.

### **Parking**

There is access for vehicles up to 7.5 tonnes for unloading and loading only. Diss is well served with public car parks with over 1000 car parking spaces in the town centre. The nearest car park is only a short walk around the corner (off Shelfanger Road). All car parks are accessible 24 hours. The first hour is free and all car parks are free on Sundays and Bank Holidays. There is no charge for parking after 6pm.

#### Rail

The station in Diss is approximately 1 mile from the Corn Hall off Victoria Road. There is a regular service north to Norwich and south to London Liverpool Street (journey time approximately 90 minutes). The last train to London leaves at 22:17. There is a train at 23:22 to Stowmarket and Ipswich.
